What is the status of subcutaneous emphysema on this chest X-ray? Options:

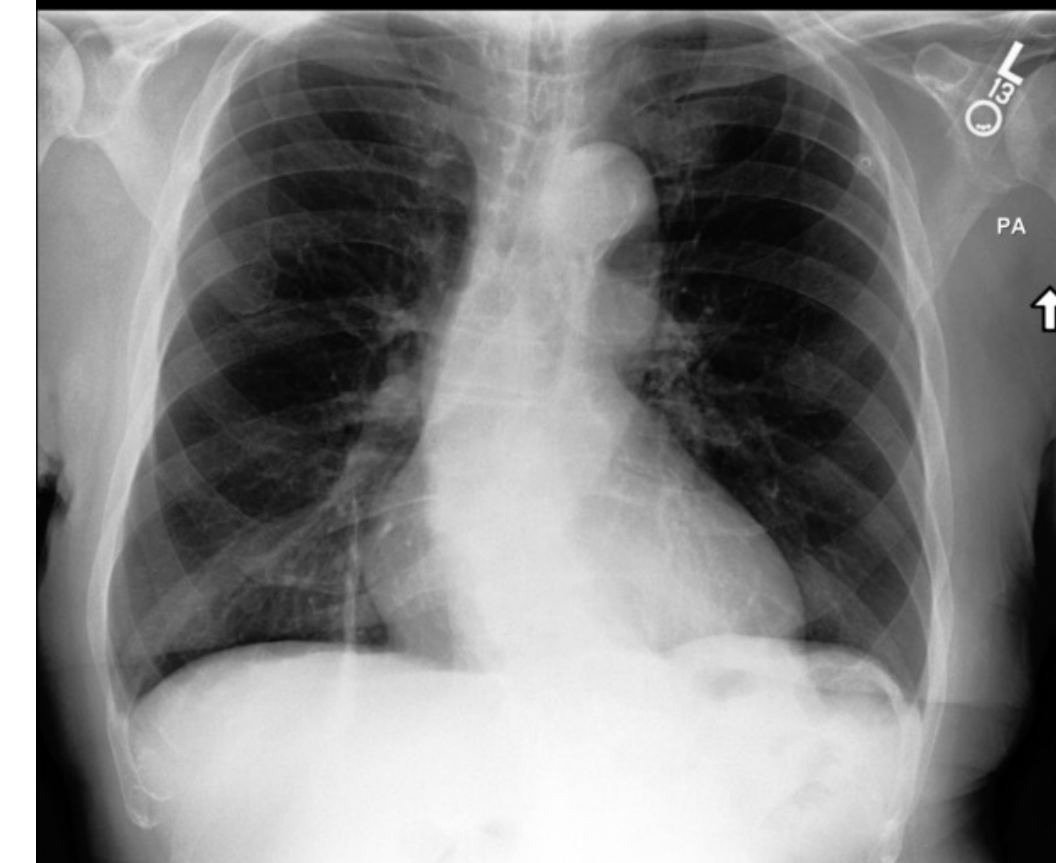
A. Subcutaneous emphysema is present
